Machine Dating Service

It is important you read all the instructions carefully.

You can apply for an age-related registration number using a Proof of age (dating) certificate if you have restored, repaired or purchased an **original vehicle**:

- that has not been previously registered in the UK.
- or
- its original UK number is not known.

The machine must be representative of how it left the factory. DVLA will only allow a change of engine.

If your vehicle has parts from other manufacturers or more modern machines, it may need to be assessed under the Reconstructed Classic Regulations. Contact us for advice

DO NOT APPLY UNTIL YOUR VEHICLE IS COMPLETE AND ROAD WORTHY

- A Proof of age (dating) certificate will be valid for 12 Months from the date of issue.

If your vehicle has been imported or was manufactured outside of the UK, you must submit a HMRC Clearance Notification (NOVA), which you can get from HMRC. (Please ensure that the correct frame number is on the NOVA confirmation.)

If we know that the vehicle in question has been exported, we are required to state this on the certificate. Contact HMRC for NOVA guidance on 0300 322 7071.

The DVLA are inspecting vehicles at random. You will be informed in writing if a vehicle inspection is required, you will not be charged. Checks may be made to ensure that the vehicle exists, and the frame and engine numbers are recorded correctly.

Do not use this form to apply to retain an original registration number. You will need to go through the V765 scheme. Download the pack from our website at <https://www.vmcc.net/Library-and-DVLA-Forms> or request a copy.

The Dating Officer of the VMCC will conduct a search based on the information and photographs provided by the applicant to establish the date of manufacture of a motorcycle and will issue a Proof of age(dating) certificate which will be considered by the DVLA for the purpose of obtaining an age-related registration number. We supply information, that is, to the best of our knowledge accurate. However, as we are not infallible, we cannot be held responsible should the information later be proved to be incorrect.

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide a dating certificate for Brough Superiors and Vincents. All other marques we will endeavour to date dependent upon the evidence we have available.

This process may take up to 6 Weeks with the VMCC.

What photographs we need:

- **A nearside view and an offside view photograph of the vehicle.** The side view images must be of the entire vehicle straight on from wheel to wheel. If any major components, such as frame, forks, engine, gearbox, wheels/hubs are obscured in the full side image then please supply individual images of that component.
- **Clear Photographs or rubbings clearly showing the frame and engine numbers.** (Which must include any prefixes and suffixes)

Gold Upgrade Service:

We are now offering a service upgrade, whereby we will complete all the necessary paperwork for you and send everything to the DVLA by recorded delivery as soon as the dating certificate has been produced.

For this service you will need to send us:

- A signed V55/5 form. These can be downloaded from our website at <https://www.vbcc.net/Library-and-DVLA-Forms> . We will complete the rest of the form on your behalf.
- A completed V112 form if your machine is MOT exempt. These can be downloaded from our website at <https://www.vbcc.net/Library-and-DVLA-Forms> .

or

A current MOT certificate stating frame number if your machine is not MOT exempt.

- **A copy of your photo-card driving licence.**

If you do not have a photo card driving license. The DVLA will accept the following:

Documents DVLA will accept to confirm your name are:

- Your current UK DVLA paper driving license (not a paper counterpart)
- Your Passport
- Your Birth certificate.
- Your decree nisi or decree absolute

Documents DVLA will accept to confirm your address are:

- A gas, electricity, water or landline phone bill issued in the last 6 months.
- Your council tax bill for the current year
- A bank or building society statement issued in the last 3 months
- A medical car/letter
- A cheque or postal order for £55.00 made payable to the DVLA.
- A cheque for Road Tax made payable to the DVLA **if your machine is not historic tax status.** The current rate of Road Tax can be found at <https://www.gov.uk/vehicle-tax-rate-tables/other-vehicle-tax-rates>.
- HMRC (Nova) Clearance Notification **if your machine has been imported or manufactured outside the UK.**
- An insurance certificate if the vehicle is being registered to an address in Northern Ireland

We will:

- Complete the V55/5 form.
- Write a covering letter to the DVLA requesting an age-related number.
- Send everything to the DVLA by recorded delivery and send you the tracking number so you can track the progress of your paperwork.
