RECONSTRUCTED CLASSIC REGISTRATION APPLICATION VMCC A3 form

If your vehicle has been built using genuine period components of the same specification, sourced from more than one vehicle your vehicle should be assessed under reconstructed classic to get an age related registration number.

Your vehicle must be a true reflection of the marque. (Please see DVLA information leaflet INF26. Guidelines on how you can register kit cars and rebuilt or radically altered vehicles for more information.)

Reconstructed classics or replica vehicles built to original specification using a mixture of new and used major components, will be issued a Q registration number. The vehicle must go through the Motorcycle Single Vehicle approval scheme - MSVA. An age related registration number will be issued based on the youngest major component used. **Major Components are:** the unchanged original frame, engine, gearbox (if separate), forks and wheels/hubs.

DO NOT APPLY UNTIL YOUR VEHICLE IS COMPLETE AND ROAD WORTHY:

- Your application will be returned if we do not have the correct photos or if the form has not been completed correctly (please see page 4 for list of requested photographs).
- A build up inspection report will be valid for 12 Months from the date of issue.

The DVLA are inspecting vehicles at random. SGS are a Swiss company who inspect vehicles on behalf of the DVLA and you will be informed in writing if a vehicle inspection is required, you will not be charged. SGS will check that the vehicle exists and the frame and engine numbers are recorded correctly.

Please supply as many of the details we ask for as possible, including any prefixes or suffixes to the Frame, Engine, Forks and Gearbox numbers. In the case of rarer machines, if you have any supporting information it may help us if you can supply photocopies.

Your vehicle will be inspected from photographs provided. The inspection report and the photographs will be sent to the VMCC marque specialist for their approval. Please allow up to 4 weeks for your inspection report to be completed.

Vehicles registered as "Reconstructed classics" will be issued with a new DVLA VIN. The DVLA may advise to obliterate the original frame number but, to avoid loss of historical traceability, we advise the use of a VIN plate instead.

What photographs you need to send:

1. Clear photos of the whole motorcycle from both sides
2. Rubbings or photographs of any numbers on the major components
3. A close up photo of the engine from both sides
4. Close up photo of the forks from the front and the sides
5. Close up photos of the hubs and wheels

We cannot supply a built-up report if you do not supply the requested photographs. Photos must be clear. You can print the photographs or email them to dvlaiaison@vmcc.net.

- A cheque for Road Tax made payable to the DVLA. The current rate of Road Tax can be found at <https://www.gov.uk/vehicle-tax-rate-tables/other-vehicle-tax-rates>.
- Receipts for parts used (if you don't have these then please provide an explanation of why, and a brief outline of the bike's history)
- A copy of your photo-card driving licence.
- A cheque or postal order for £55.00 made payable to the DVLA, for first Registration Fee.
- An insurance Certificate if the motorcycle is being registered to an address in Northern Ireland

We will:

- Complete the V55/5 and V627/1 forms
- Write a covering letter to the DVLA requesting an age related number.
- Send everything to the DVLA by recorded delivery and send you the tracking number so you can track the progress of your paperwork.
- To register your machine with an age related number, the DVLA require a payment of £55.00. They only accept cheques, postal orders or banker's drafts. If you would like us to write a cheque for you and send it with your paperwork, just add £55.00 to your total payment and we will do that for you.

The price includes all the postage costs.
