# Introduction, rules including how to claim way points



#### General guidance

- None of the way points are manned (as in a Relay Rally)
- Members are invited to make their own way to the Way Points contained in this booklet
- You can ride in groups subject to the rules of your nation or alone
- Please check the details against a map, do not assume they are correct – we could have made a simple typing error
- We have supplied post codes and for most grid references and three word references too; these can be for the car park, the centre of the Way Point or somewhere nearby

- The Way Points locations should be checked prior to travel; using a number of useful tools such as Google maps, OS maps and https://gridreferencefinder
- The sections are grouped under their VMCC geographic areas
- Please check opening times before travelling many may be amended due to on going Covid/business issues
- Remember your Covid kits gel and mask: maintain social distancing from other members at stops, people who come over to look at your bike and staff at locations you visit



# Introduction, rules including how to claim way points



Rule 1: Local Covid regulations apply – this could include limits to group sizes, closure of way points, limitation to cafés, please check before travelling.

Rule 2: To claim a Way Point - send an e-mail to nwp@vmcc.net with your name and membership number, the section's name who nominated the way point(s) e.g. North Tamar, with the way point's name you are claiming and a photo of the way point with your motorcycle on it or groups of riders and their motorcycles. In sending in your first Way Point e-mail you have entered the event. If visiting multiple way points on one day simply add to the e-mail. Please send your e-mails within a day of so of each visit; that way we can track the event and even the work load of processing the claims.

Rule 3: Riding in groups but subject to Covid rules is to be encouraged. Please supply additional names with your submission e-mail as above.

Rule 4: VMCC eligible machines should be used as much as possible.

Rule 5: A Way Point may be changed during the event; notification will be sent by e-mail to those active under rule 1 and posted on the VMCC web site. Rule 6: This Rally is for the pleasure of riding with friends, it is non-competitive. No entrance fee will be charged.

Rule 7: All communication is via the e-mail address, nwp@vmcc.net. This address will be closed once the event has finished.

Rule 8: The event will run from Wednesday 16-Jun-21 until Wednesday 15-Sep-21.

Rule 9: Photographs submitted may be shared within the VMCC (Allen House), published in the Journal or on Facebook, etc. as way of promoting the event and the VMCC and with 3rd party organisations to gain press coverage for the club and the event.

Rule 10: It is permitted to include Way Points within Section runs and make a mass claim (see rule 2 above), the Way Point can be from your own Section or another Section.



## The photographic competition



We will be running a photographic competition as part of the National Way Point Rally. Mailed in photographs will be allocated to one of three categories:

- The photograph that best sums up the spirit of the VMCC
- The best group photograph of flat tanks, pre-war saddle tanks and classic bikes together at a Way Point
- The best group photograph including eligible Japanese machines

Either mark which category you are going for or leave to us to allocate.

Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### Hints and tips:

We are working on the basis most members will use smart phone camera to capture their visits. With i-phones for example, take the photo using the camera icon, tap the photos icon, tap the photo you want to send, then using the button i bottom left, to take you into the sharing screen, select mail, and send the email as described above (and including the details) to nwp@vmcc.net- selecting actual size as you send it.

Standalone cameras can be used send the photo as a jpg attachment in the usual way.




