Statement of Search (S.o.S.)

It is important you read all the instructions carefully.

You can apply for an age-related registration number using a statement of search (dating) certificate if you have restored, repaired or purchased an **original vehicle**:

- that has not been previously registered in the UK.
or
- its original UK number is not known.

The machine must be representative of how it left the factory. DVLA will only allow a change of engine.

Before applying for an age-related number, it is strongly recommended to check if the DVLA have a record of your frame number on file. (DVLA - 0300 790 6802). If they do have a record of it, then the original registration can be retained through a V62 form.

If your vehicle has been built from genuine period parts of the same specification sourced from more than one vehicle, all over 25 years old, your vehicle may need to be assessed under Reconstructed Classic Regulations. Contact us for advice.

DO NOT APPLY UNTIL YOUR VEHICLE IS COMPLETE AND ROAD WORTHY

- A statement of search (dating) certificate will be valid for 12 Months from the date of issue.

If your vehicle has been imported, you must submit a HMRC Clearance Notification (NOVA), which you can get from HMRC.

If we know that the vehicle in question has been exported, we are required to state this on the certificate. Contact HMRC for NOVA guidance on 0300 322 7071.

The DVLA are inspecting vehicles at random. SGS are a Swiss company who inspect vehicles on behalf of the DVLA and you will be informed in writing if a vehicle inspection is required, you will not be charged. SGS will check that the vehicle exists and the frame and engine numbers are recorded correctly.

Do not use this form to apply to retain an original registration number. You will need to go through the V765 scheme. Download the pack from our website at <https://www.vmcc.net/Library-and-DVLA-Forms> or request a copy.

The Dating Officer of the VMCC will conduct a search based on the information and photographs provided by the applicant to establish the date of manufacture of a motorcycle and will issue a "Statement of Search" certificate which will be considered by the DVLA for the purpose of obtaining an age-related registration number. We supply information, that is, to the best of our knowledge accurate. However, as we are not infallible, we cannot be held responsible should the information later be proved to be incorrect.

What photographs we need:

- **A nearside view and an offside view photograph of the vehicle.** The side view images must be of the entire vehicle straight on from wheel to wheel. If any major components, such as frame, forks, engine, gearbox, wheels/hubs are obscured in the full side image then please supply individual images of that component.
- **Photographs or rubbings clearly showing the frame and engine numbers.**

Enhanced Service:

We are now offering an “enhanced” service, whereby we will complete all the necessary paperwork for you and send everything to the DVLA by recorded delivery as soon as the dating certificate has been produced.

For this service you will need to send us:

- A signed V55/5 form. These can be downloaded from our website at <https://www.vmcc.net/Library-and-DVLA-Forms> . We will complete the rest of the form on your behalf.
- A completed V112 form if your machine is MOT exempt. These can be downloaded from our website at <https://www.vmcc.net/Library-and-DVLA-Forms> .

or

- A current MOT certificate if your machine is not MOT exempt.
- A copy of your photo-card driving licence.
- A cheque or postal order for £55.00 made payable to the DVLA.
- A cheque for Road Tax made payable to the DVLA **if your machine is not historic tax status.** The current rate of Road Tax can be found at <https://www.gov.uk/vehicle-tax-rate-tables/other-vehicle-tax-rates>.
- HMRC (Nova) Clearance Notification if your machine has been imported.

We will:

- Complete the V55/5 form.
- Write a covering letter to the DVLA requesting an age-related number.
- Send everything to the DVLA by recorded delivery and send you the tracking number so you can track the progress of your paperwork.
